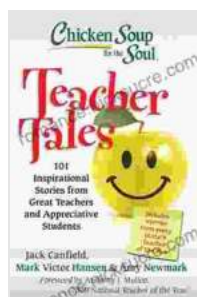

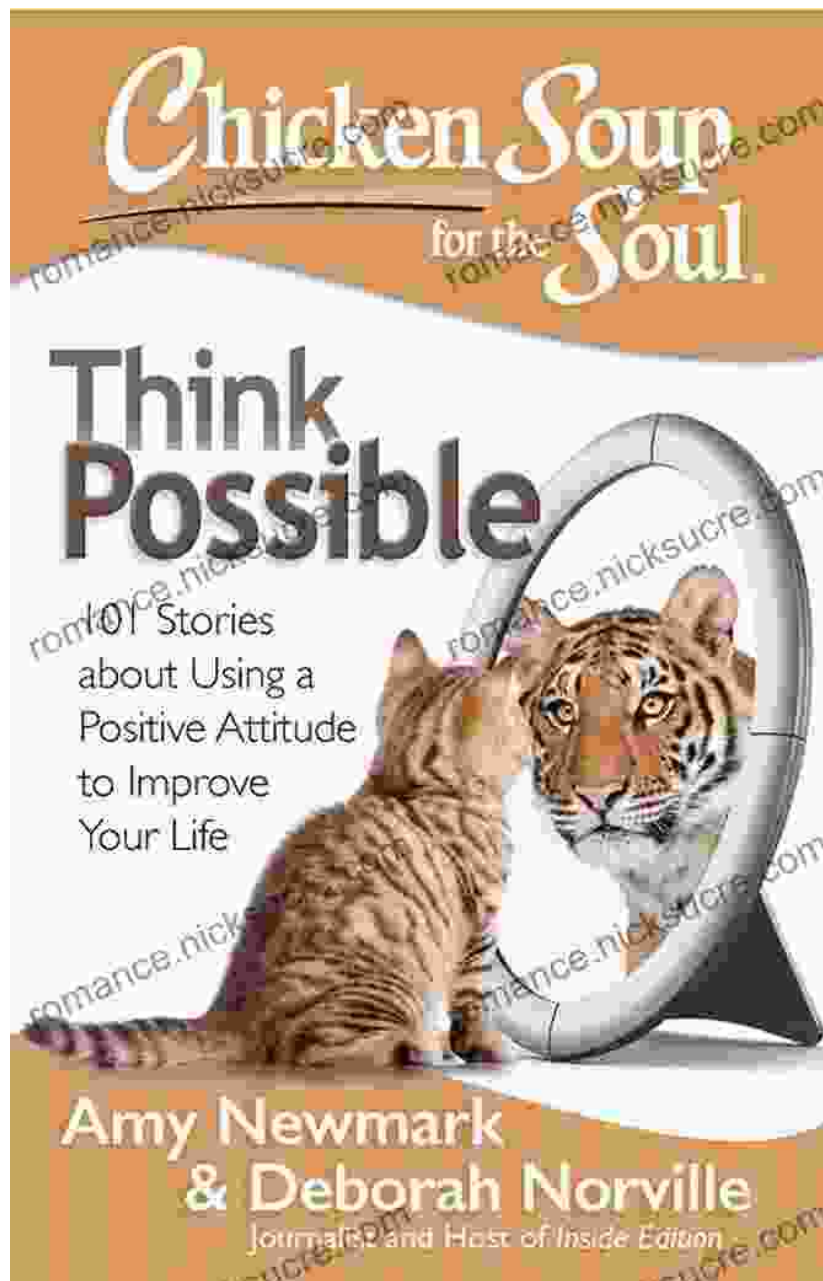

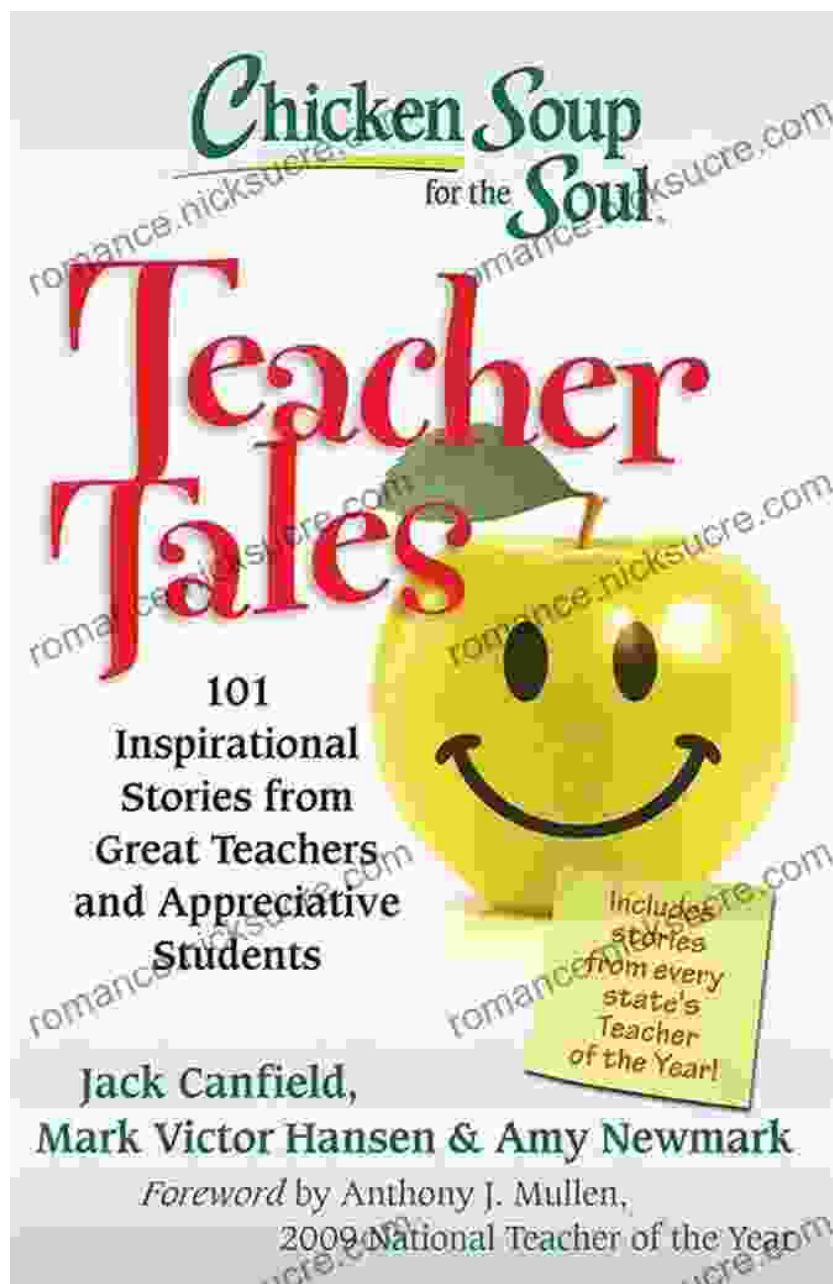
- **The Teacher Who Inspired a Future President**

▪ The Teacher Who Changed a Student's Life

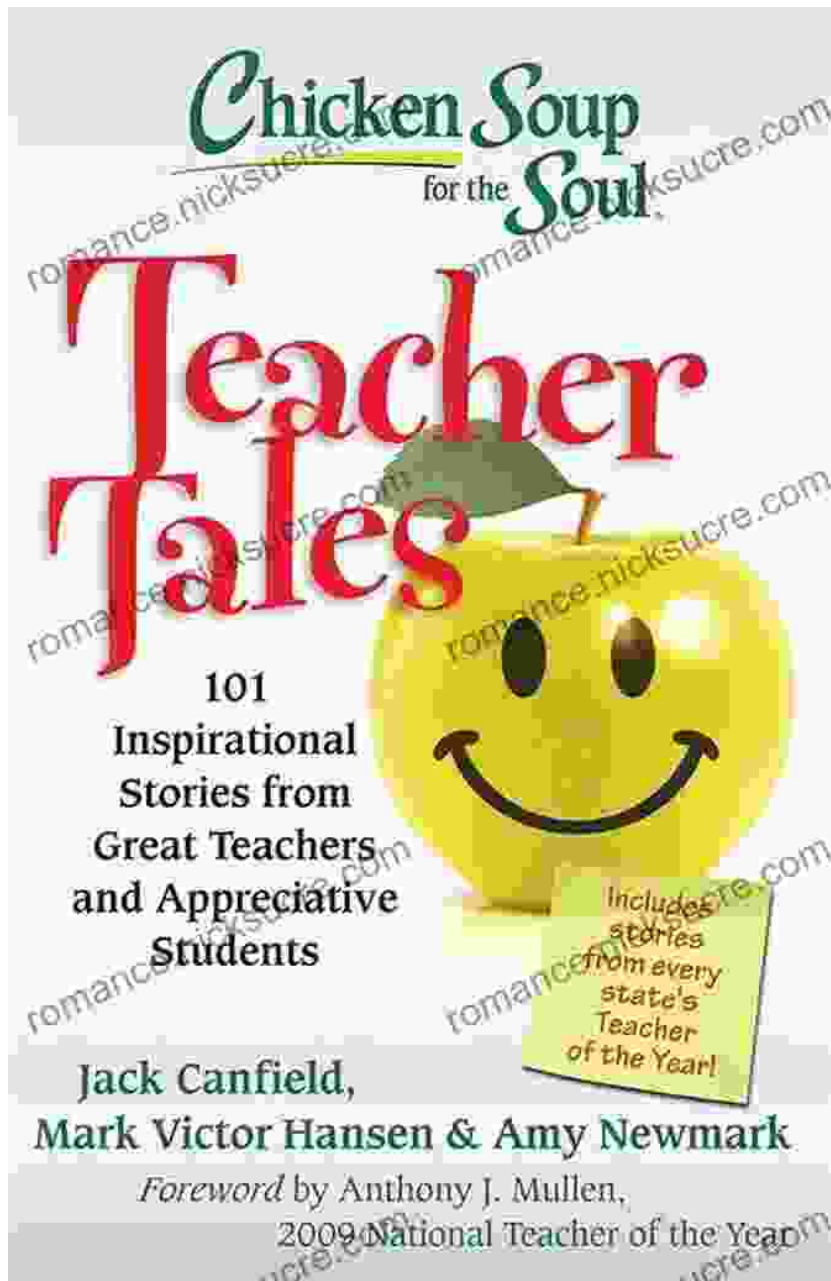

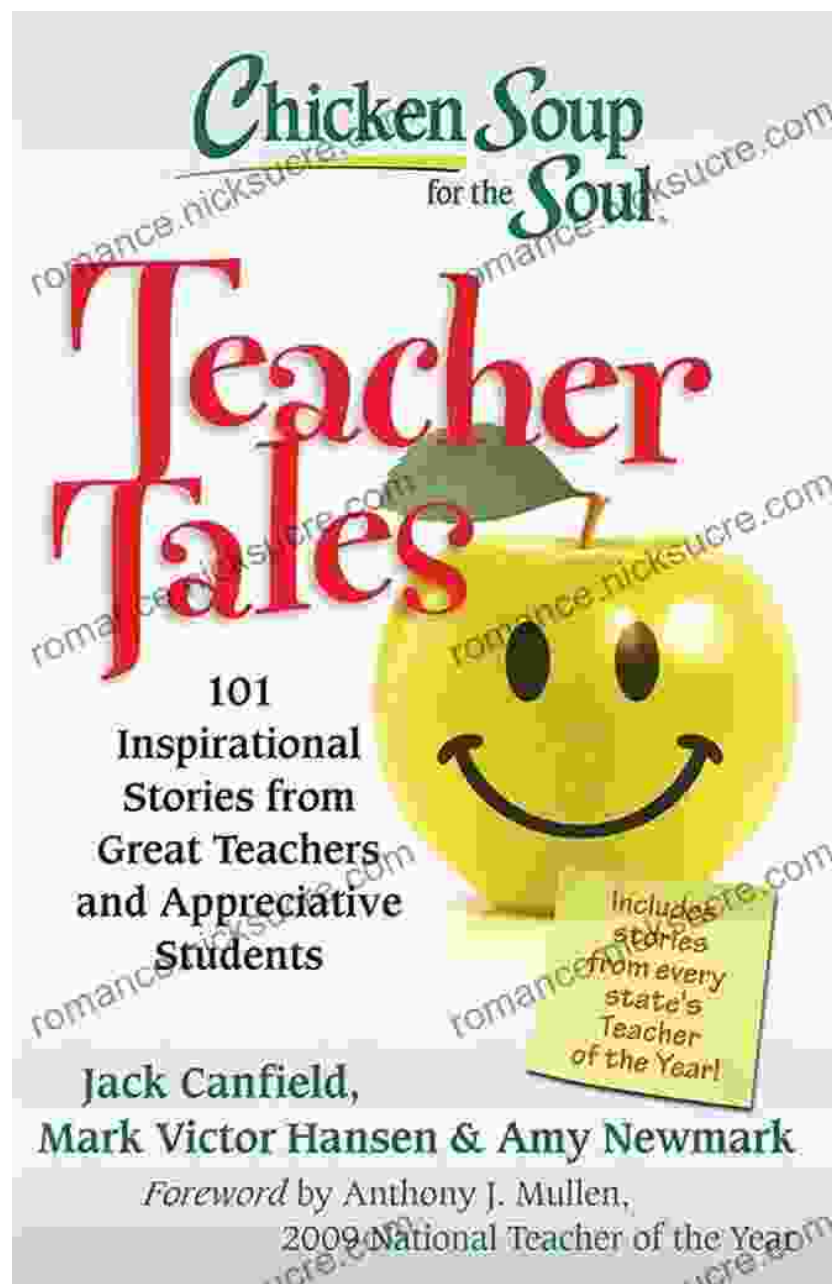


Stories of Dedication

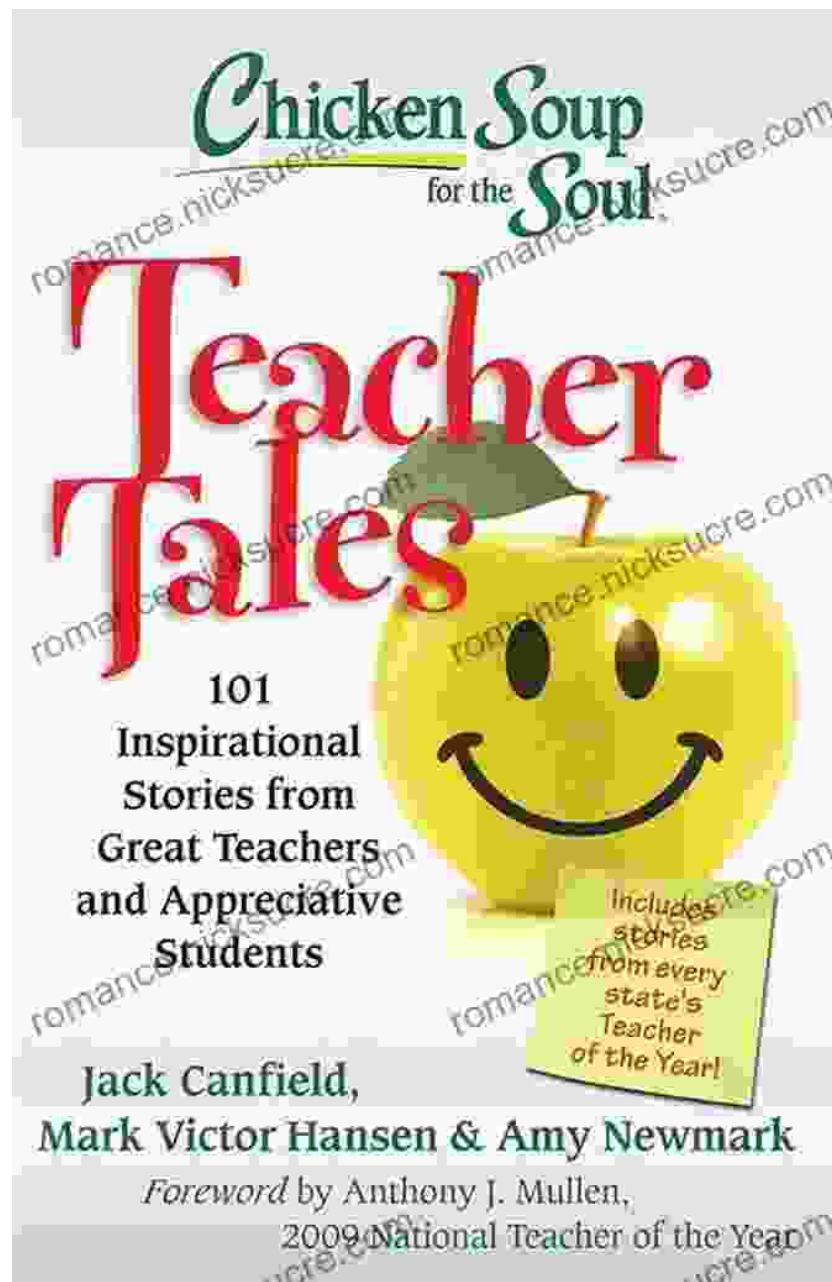
their homework and to take them on field trips. He has also created a foundation to help provide scholarships to underprivileged students.



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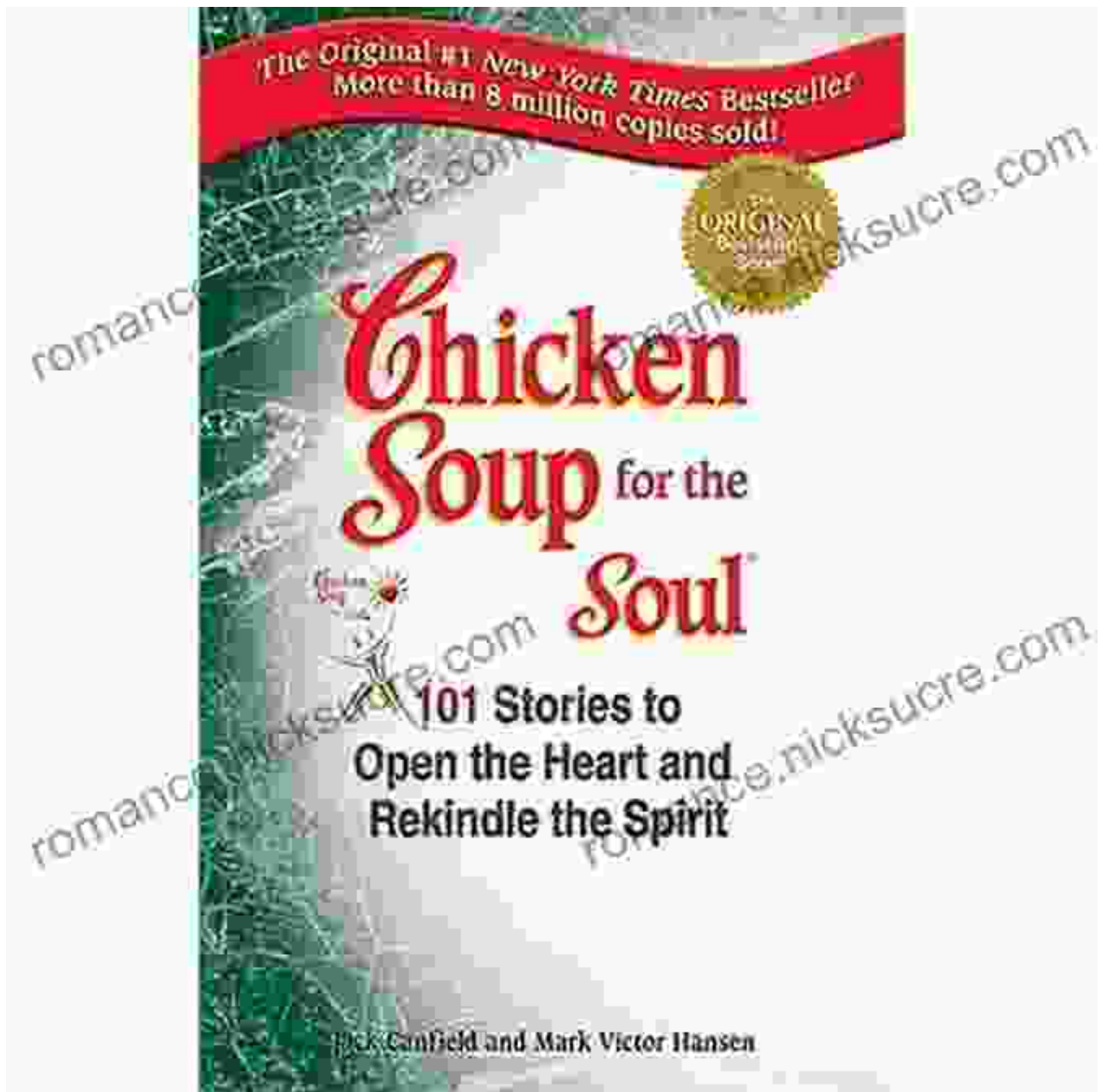
- **The Teacher Who Never Gave Up**

- **The Student Who Thanked Her Teacher**

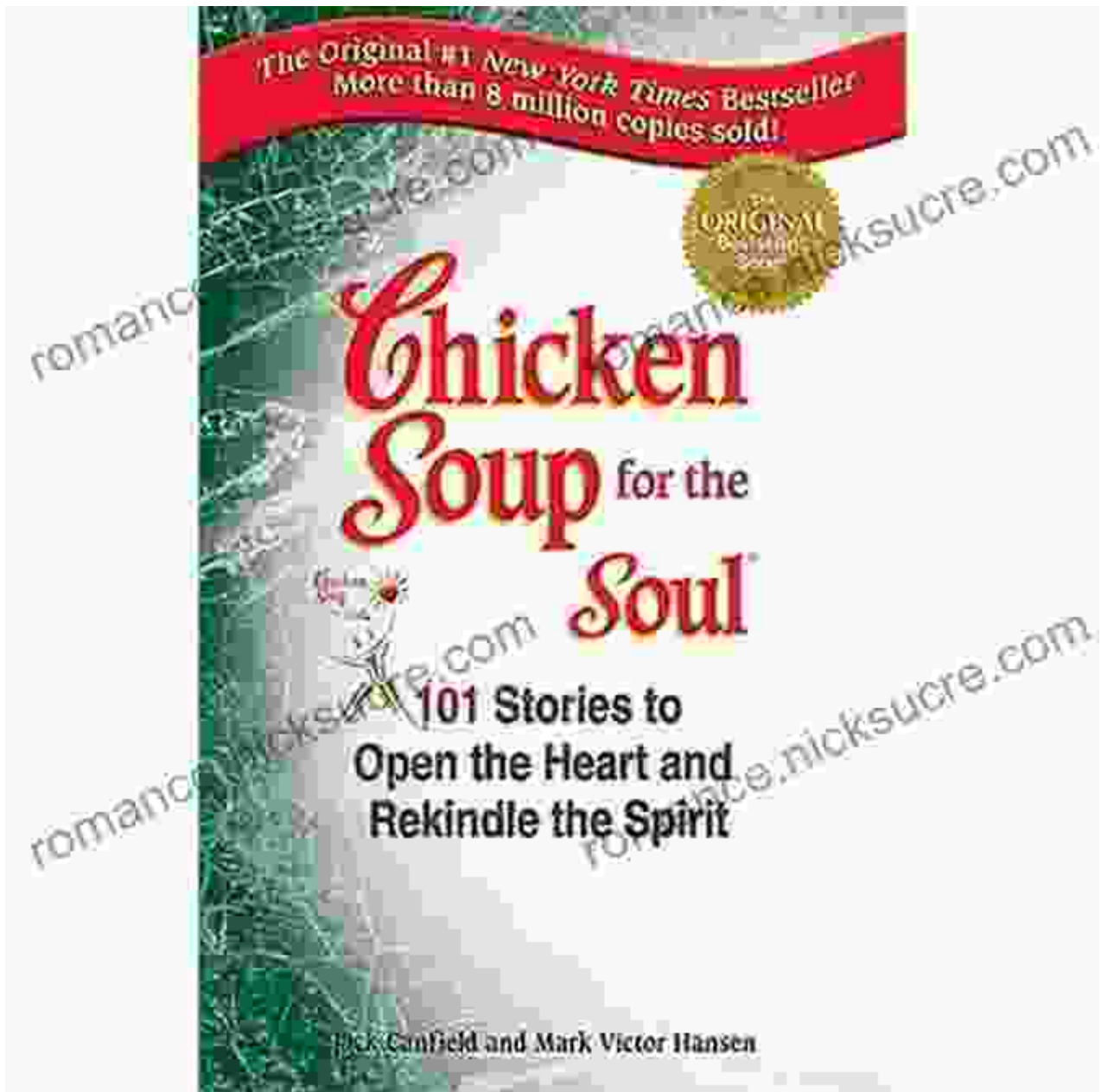

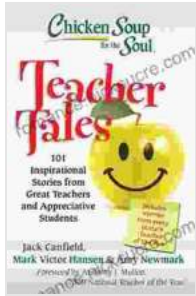
- **The Student Who Inspired a Teacher**

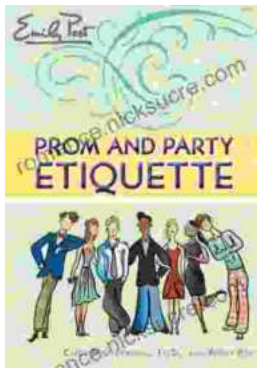

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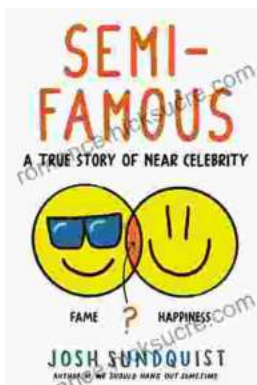
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
