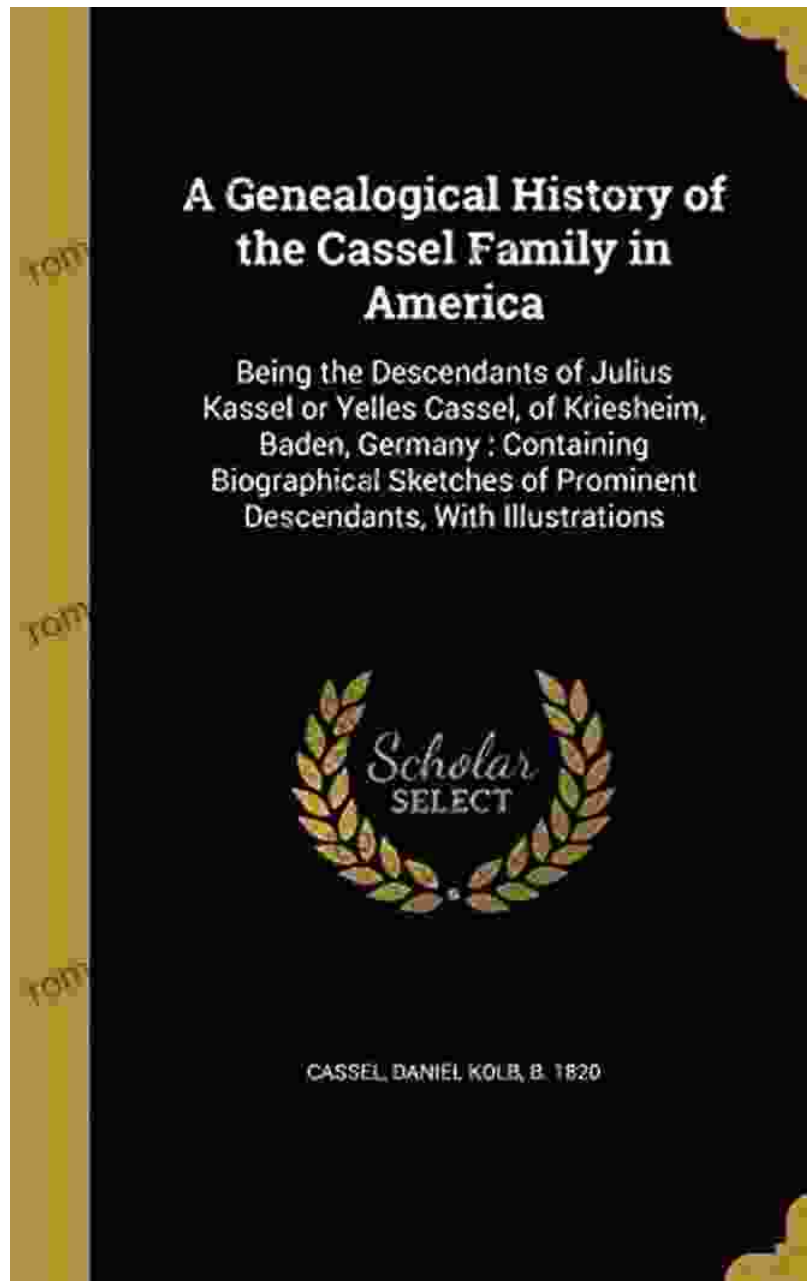


Alexander the Great and His Heirs

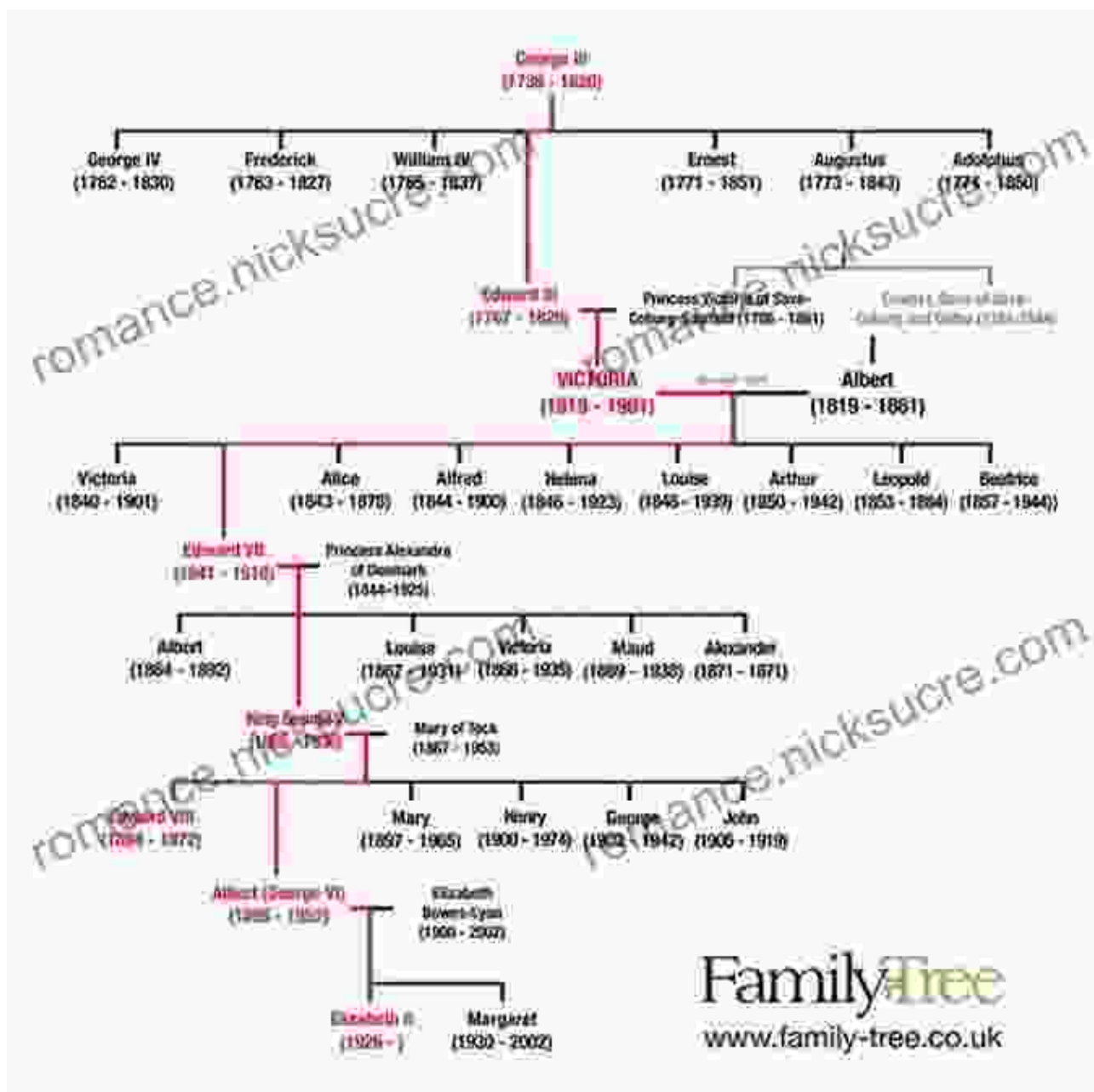

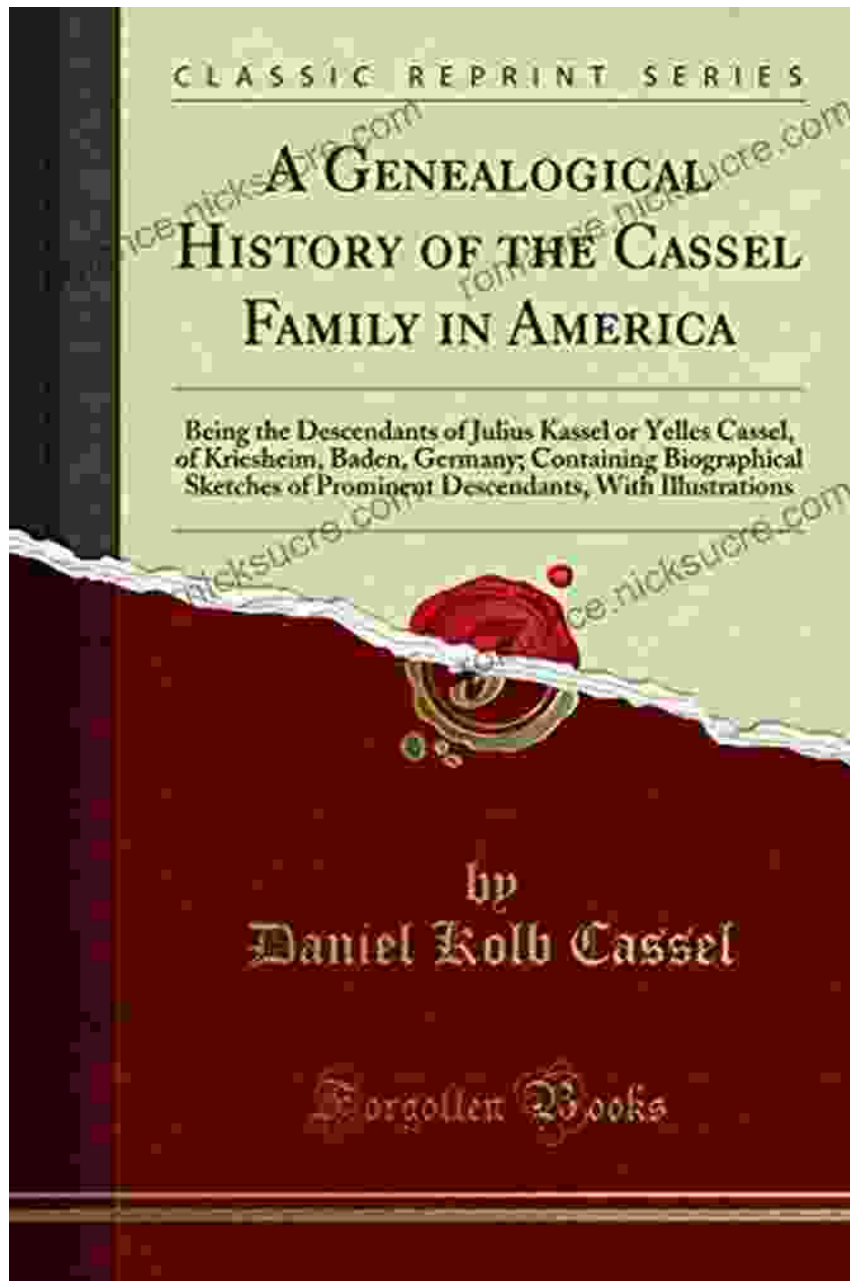

Thomas Edison and His Legacy

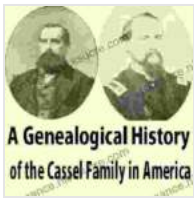
Thomas Edison was an American inventor who is credited with developing the electric light bulb, the phonograph, and the motion picture camera. He

- **Charles Edison:** Edison's great-grandson, who was a politician and businessman. He served as Governor of New Jersey from 1974 to 1982.



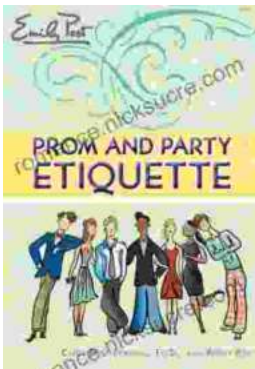

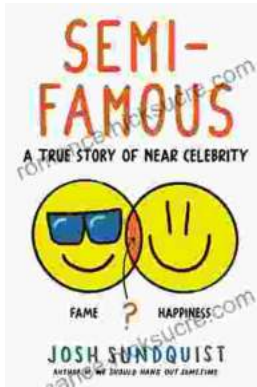
