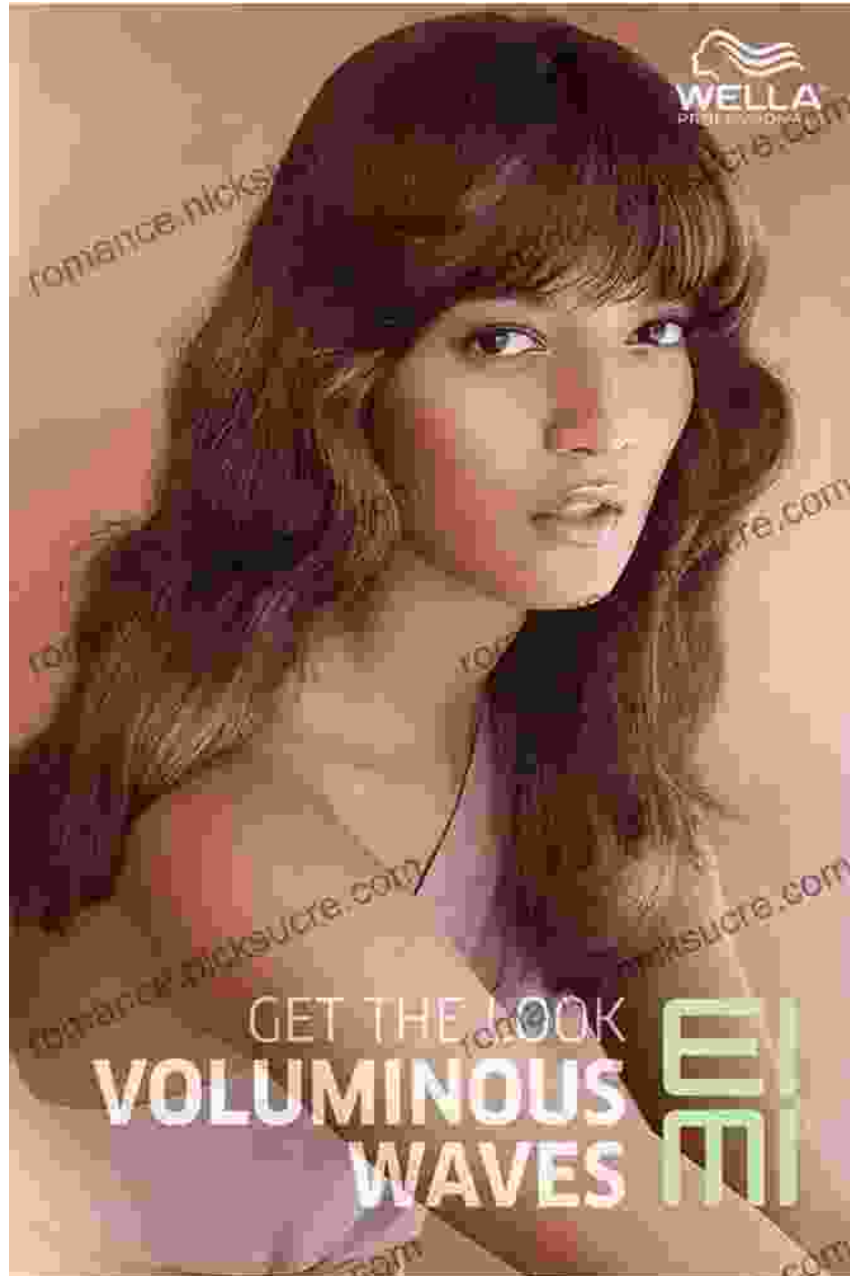
Everyday Hairstyles

3. Braided Bun

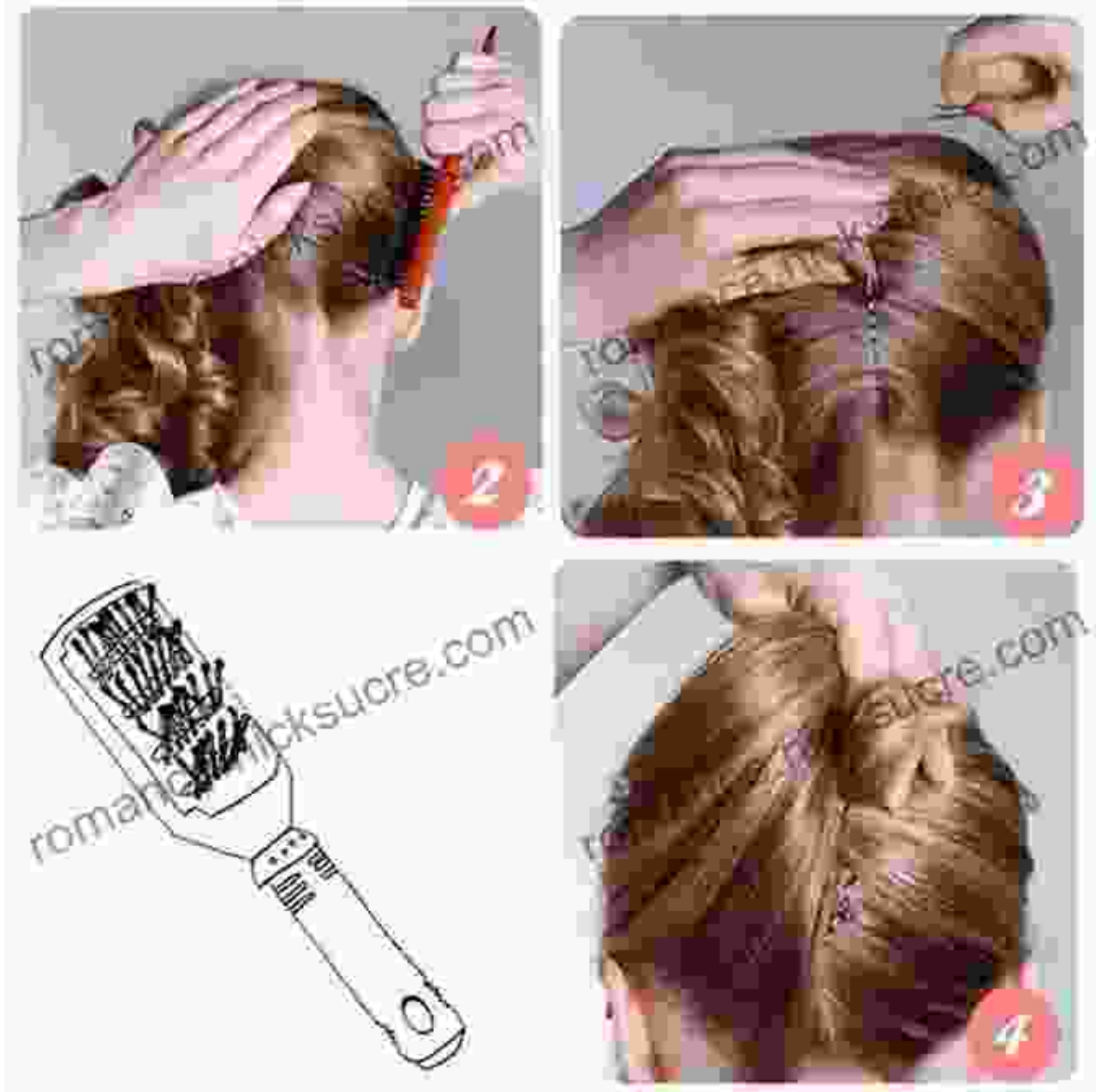

6. Finish with a light hairspray to hold the style.

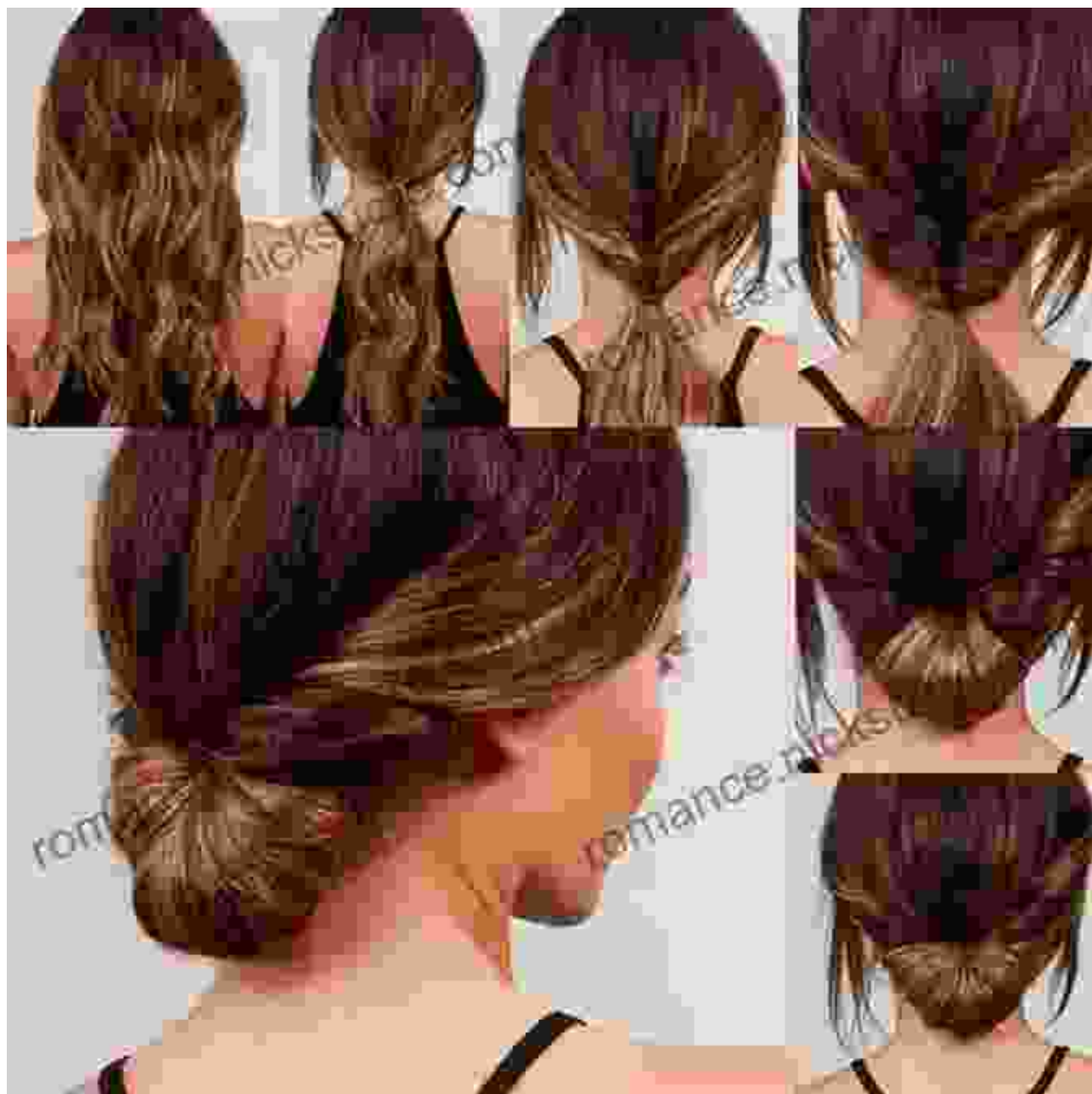
Wedding Hairstyles

4. Secure the twists with bobby pins, leaving some loose strands around the edges for a romantic look.

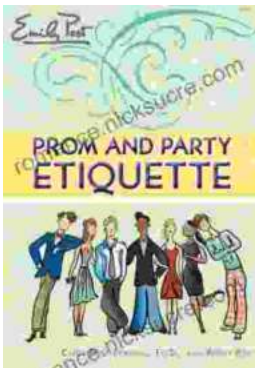

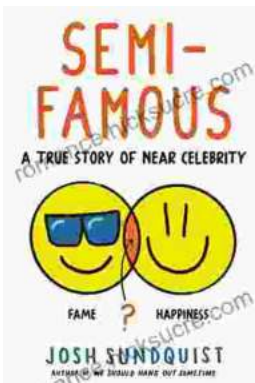
