## **Behind the Scenes**

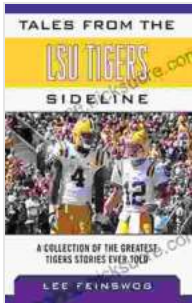

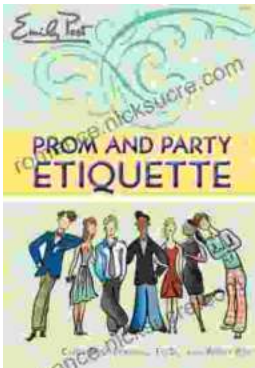
