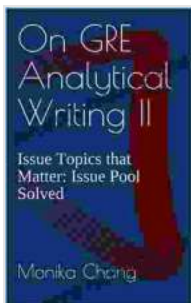
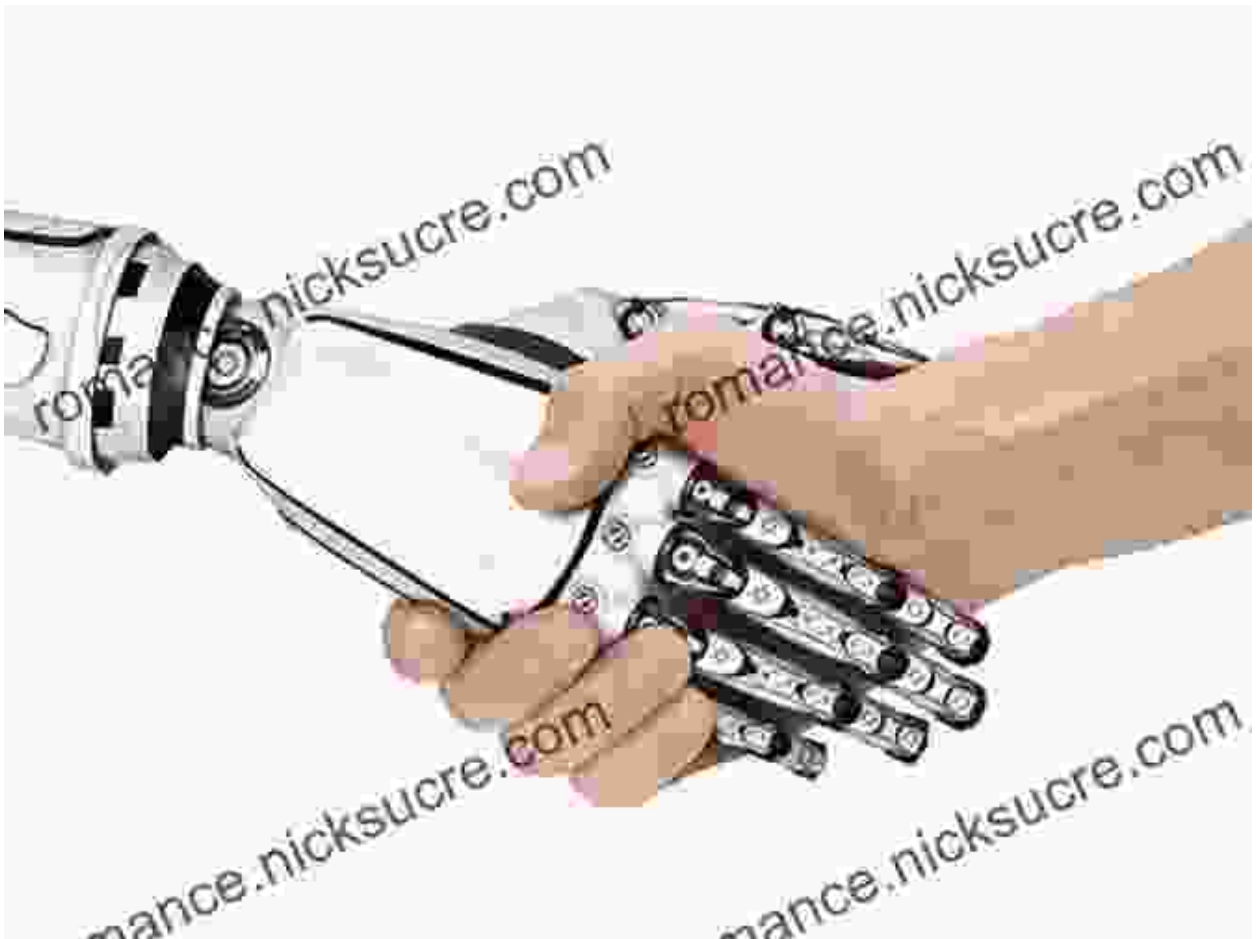
Ethical Dilemmas

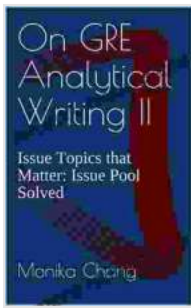

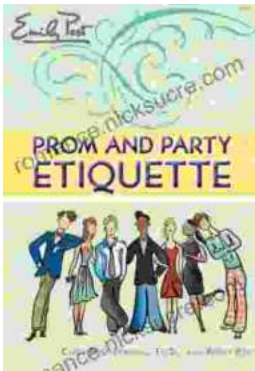

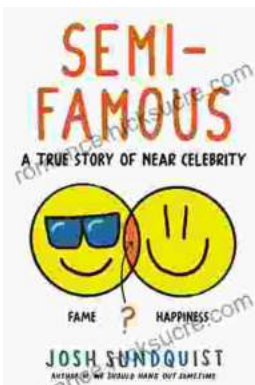
